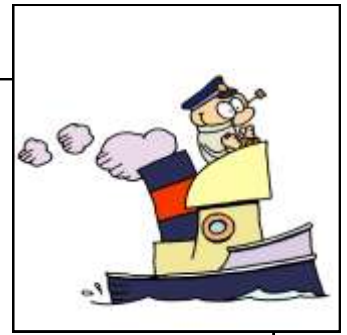

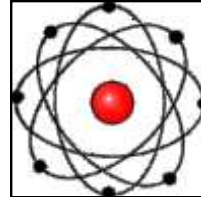

March 8th—Residents Only Daily, Weekly or Full Camp

March 16th Non Residents Daily, Weekly or Full Camp

Initial Registration MUST Be in Person During Office Hours—No Mail In or Drop Off Registrations will be accepted.

Registrations Ends **June 18, 2010** or until space allows. If there are still spots open, registration will reopen on Tuesday June 29, 2010. We recommend downloading all forms and filling them out prior to arriving to register. Fill in all information possible and we will help you with the rest. Forms will be available at our website www.sacoparksandrec.com or at the Community Center at 75 Franklin St. All forms must be complete and legible to guarantee a spot at camp.

Anyone with special medical needs such as epi-pens and inhalers must set up a meeting with the Program Director prior to registering.

All Weekly and Full Summer Fees are due before the start of the program. Additional weeks maybe added once the summer starts but you must notify the office before Thursday of the week prior to attending. **Same day registrations will not be allowed.** Registrations will not be accepted from any family with an outstanding balance from other Saco Parks & Recreation Programs. No credits from other programs will be carried over to the Summer.
